## Full description

Set within 1200 acres of rolling hills, cool lakes and vibrant vineyards, Predator Ridge's remote location makes it an avid golfer's paradise. Links style layouts on 3 distinct nines make this 27-hole facility one of the most desired golf destinations in Western Canada.

**Friday** morning is the beginning of your Golf Adventure at the Kelowna airport where your PGA Professional guide will be waiting to take you to the resort in a luxury vehicle. As we make the 30 minute trip, we'll pass stunning Kalamalka Lake, rated by National Geographic as one of the top ten most beautiful lakes in the world.

Once you check into your deluxe suite, your PGA Pro will meet you on the lesson tee for an introduction and preliminary instruction. With our intimate 3:1 ratio we ensure personalized attention from your grip, aim and setup to your course strategy; your Pro is at your service not only throughout each round, but the entire stay.

Friday evening's dinner is at the resort's Gallery Restaurant – after a few refreshing cocktails, of course.

**Saturday** morning begins with a leisurely breakfast followed by a round on the links. Course management is the agenda for the day and our pros specialize in strategies of the game.
